

SUCCESSFUL INAUGURATION OF THE BOURSE BEURS

This Saturday, 11.000 people joined in the festivities around the inauguration of the Bourse Beurs in the centre of Brussels. It was a day full of activities, tours of the building, a community village, music, etc. Brussels citizens, Belgians and visitors alike were able to discover this iconic building in our capital.

As a matter of fact, since its creation in 1868, this is the first time in its history that the Bourse has become a public space open to the public every day from 9.30am to 6pm, with several areas accessible free of charge: not only areas for socialising and creativity or places to eat like the brasserie Madame Café, but also work spaces such as a meeting or conference rooms.

The Bourse Beurs also houses museum and experiential spaces, including Belgian Beer World, an immersive museum conceived to retrace the history of Belgian beer, which is a UNESCO intangible heritage. 566 people visited the BBW yesterday.
